PALLADINO HISTORY

Starting from 1974 Palladino family manage the company drawing inspiration from the principle of fidelity to tradition and the characteristics of the territory. A simple philosophy, focused on the link with tradition, on respect for the terroir and the passion with which they communicate these values throughout the world. The TERRITORY finds expression in the purity of production of the historical Piedmontese denominations and in the ability each wine possesses, capable of summarising, with its own aroma and flavour, the specifics of the grapes' terroir of origin.

TASTING NOTES

The 2015 Barolo Parafada is a beautifully supple and velvety expression that wraps smoothly but thickly over the palate. The wine imparts dark fruit aromas with plum, pressed blackberry, tar, smoke and tobacco. Despite the immediate power of the wine, it ultimately performs with elegance and softness. These Barolos from 2015 tend to be more accessible overall and are suited to medium or long-term drinking.

VINEYARD

Located on the far eastern side of the Barolo production zone, Serralunga d'Alba has always been considered one of the most important among the appellation's townships, a consequence both of the excellent level of many of its vineyards and of the inimitable character of its Barolo, at times solid and austere, at other times surprisingly elegant and expressive. Parafada, located in the north part of the village, with a South exposure, gives life to a Barolo that is endowed with that vigor and a significant presence on the nose and palate that a superior category vineyard must offer.

WINEMAKING

Harvest was in October 7th. Long fermentation (30 days) in stainless steel at a 86°F. Malolactic fermentation in December in concrete barrel. In the month of June 2016 was placed for 2 years in big barrels of French oak. Bottled in the month of August 2018 spent one year in the bottle before the sale.
